- O2-25-04 The Nashville Downtown Partnership (NDP) has been approved for a two-year pilot program to manage and activate Riverfront Park. The NDP is now proposing a trial run of a Makers/Farmer's Market which is not included in the pilot program. This event would be held under the John Seigenthaler Pedestrian bridge (between 2nd and 3rd Avenues) for three days April 12, May 10, June 14, 2025. This area is Metro Parks property. Council District 19
- O2-25-05 The Hillsboro-West End Neighborhood Association (HWEN) requests acceptance of an in-kind grant, valued at approximately \$4,000, to provide tags for existing trees and a sign for the HWEN Arboretum, to include Fannie Mae Dees Park. The project was certified in November 2024 as a Level Two Arboretum by the Tennessee Urban Forestry Council (TUFC). HWEN agrees to maintain TUFC recertification, tree tags, and arboretum signage going forward. There is no required match by Metro Parks associated with this grant. No money will be sent to Metro Parks. The Arboretum project will be paid for directly by the HWEN Association. Council District 18
- **02-25-06** Staff requests acceptance of a grant, in the amount of \$15,581, from the Centennial Park Conservancy for Parthenon conferences during calendar year 2025. This funding will be used to underwrite costs for educational conferences, travel, and related expenses for Parthenon staff. There is no required match or other obligation by Parks associated with this grant. Council District 21
- Vanderbilt Delta Delta Sorority requests permission to host a Charity Pickleball Tournament at the Centennial Sportsplex (pickleball courts) to raise funds for Monroe Carell Jr. Children's Hospital. The proposed tournament will utilize eight pickleball courts on February 21, 2025, from 10:45 a.m. - 2:15 p.m. Council District 21
- **02-25-08** Staff requests approval to officially name a creek in Bells Bend Park "Poplar Creek". The stream originates in Poplar Hollow which is why it is known as Poplar Creek.
