Any person or other entity considering an appeal should consult with an attorney to ensure that time and procedural requirements are met.”

The opportunity to provide public comment is offered on a first come, first served basis. At all meetings, the commissioner chairing the proceedings shall have the authority to manage/limit the number of persons (non-Commission members) allowed to speak on an issue and to manage/limit such speakers' time.
