<u>Code Provision:</u> Per 2018 IPC 1002.1 Fixture Traps:.....The vertical distance from the fixture outlet to the trap weir shall not exceed 24 inches and the horizontal distance shall not exceed 30 inches measured from the centerline of the fixture outlet to the centerline of the inlet of the trap....

<u>Variance Requested</u>: Due to the location of the proposed piping and a conflict with an NES electrical vault, the horizontal run must exceed the code limitation of 30 inches to place the trap outside of the NES vault
