If you are not satisfied with a decision of the Metropolitan Beer Permit Board regarding your application or your hearing, you may appeal the decision to the Davidson County Chancery or Circuit Court pursuant to the requirements set forth in T.C.A. 57-5-108. The decisions of the Metropolitan Beer Permit Board take effect on a date to be determined by the board. However, you may file an appeal within 60 days of the date of entry of the board's decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met.

(Alleged violation of M.C.L 7.08.140C It is unlawful for any beer permit

holder or his agent or employee to make or permit to be made any sale of

beer to a person under twenty-one years of age. (1st Offense ~~x2~~)

T.C.A 57-5-301(a)(1) prior to making a sale of beer for off-premise consumption, state law requires

identification for the sale of beer. (1st Offense x2)

T.C.A 39-17-1504(a) It is unlawful for any person to sell or distribute any tobacco, smoking hemp, or

vapor product to another person who has not attained twenty-one (21) years of age or to purchase a tobacco,

smoking hemp, or vapor product on behalf of such person under twenty-one (21) years of age. (1st Offense)

T.C.A 39-17-1504(d) A person engaged in the sale or distribution of tobacco, smoking hemp, or vapor products

shall demand proof of age from a prospective purchaser or recipient if an ordinary person would conclude on the basis of appearance that the prospective purchaser or recipient may be under thirty (30) years

of age. In the case of distribution by mail, the distributor of tobacco, smoking hemp, or vapor products shall

obtain from the addressee an affirmative statement that the person is twenty-one (21) years of age or

older, and shall inform the recipient that the person is strictly prohibited from distributing any tobacco,

smoking hemp, or vapor product, as defined by this part, to any person under twenty-one (21) years of

age on or about April 30, 2025). (1st Offense)

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: ~~\$4000~~ Civil Penalty (Changed to \$3,500)

Notes: The Board was alerted to an error made by staff regarding this complaint. The complaint initially indicated two violations of M.C.L. 7.08.140C, but it was clarified during the meeting that there was only one violation. One of the individuals involved was over the age of 21 and was used to test whether the location checks IDs, as required by state law. Therefore, the civil penalty amount should be adjusted to \$3,500 instead of \$4,000.
