Vaulx Lane STORMWATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Council Member Terry Vo will be hosting a community meeting with Metro Water Services Stormwater Division to discuss the potential for a large-scale stormwater improvement project in the vicinity of Vaulx Lane, from Hillview Heights to Kirkwood Avenue. The meeting will focus on schematic without survey to improve the existing stormwater conveyance system that runs along the rear of properties in this area. The proposed improvements aim to address drainage concerns and reduce flooding.

This meeting will provide an opportunity to learn how your property will be affected by a drainage improvement project. Impacts could include roadside ditch grading, replacement or upsizing of driveway pipes, removal and resetting of fences or mailboxes, tree removal, and the installation of culverts or other stormwater infrastructure. In some cases, removal of drainage flow obstructions—such as decks, pedestrian bridges, or fences—may also be necessary.
