



LOOKING UP HISTORIC OVERLAYS IN PARCEL VIEWER

Go to: <http://maps.nashville.gov/ParcelViewer/>


1. Enter address, parcel number or owner in the search bar just above the map.
2. Click on the magnifying glass to the right of the search bar.




3. Click on the "map layers" at the top for a pop-up window. Scroll down the popup window to "zoning." (Scroll past "historic districts," to the "zoning" layer, as "historic districts" denotes properties listed or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places. Properties listed in the National Register may or may not also be in a local historic overlay.)




4. At “zoning” click on the left arrow, so that it is facing down. That will give you additional sub options, under zoning.



5. Keep scrolling down and click on all layers that start with “historic.”



6. Properties in one of the overlays will not have some type of hatching. Click on the “key” to see what type of hatching references different types of historic overlays.



7. To see the name of the district, click the small arrow to the right in the main pop up until you see the one labeled “Historic”. From here, you can also click on “view design guidelines” to go directly to the website.
