If you are not satisfied with a decision of the Metropolitan Beer Permit Board regarding your application or your hearing, you may appeal the decision to the Davidson County Chancery or Circuit Court pursuant to the requirements set forth in T.C.A. 57-5-108. The decisions of the Metropolitan Beer Permit Board take effect on a date to be determined by the board. However, you may file an appeal within 60 days of the date of entry of the board's decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met.

Inspector Brown provided his testimony of the event that occurred on or about May 5, 2024, which involved unlicensed security guards hitting patrons and carrying an unauthorized weapon. The security guards were arrested and charged with aggravated assault and impersonating a licensed security guard. Inspector Brown informed the Board that all charges were dropped, but that the Board has the discretion to cite the permit holder based upon the evidence submitted.

The MNPD officers confirmed the accuracy of the violation and provided additional details on the security guards' charges. Officer Mendoza-Aguilera added that the workers at the establishment could not identify who was in charge on the night of the incident.

McGrath testified about her ownership history, lack of bar management experience, and corrective steps taken, including terminating prior management and contracting with a licensed security company. She expressed regret and committed to improving operations.

The Board voted to issue a \$1,000 civil penalty or the option to serve a 5-day suspension, followed by 30 days of probation.

Salary Discussion

Executive Director Benton McDonough provided a summary of the revenue report to the Board. The Board had no questions or concerns.

The Board also reviewed a request for a merit-based salary increase for the Executive Director. The proposal called for up to a 3% increase, contingent upon adequate funding in the upcoming fiscal year budget.

Ms. Jarmon asked if staff were also receiving an increase in pay. Mr. McDonough informed the Board that staff would be receiving an across-the-board merit increase in pay equal to the director's approved increase based on the approval of the budget.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the up to 3% merit-based pay increase, subject to the availability of funds in the approved annual budget.

Ms. Jarmon made a motion for the director to receive up to a 3% merit-based pay increase, based on adequate funding in the annual budget. Mr. Conway seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
