OFFICE OF HOMELESS SERVICES

- **Hours:** 9AM-12PM (on days of extreme heat).
- **Services:** Mobilized throughout the city.
 - Water distribution
 - Cool ride bus passes distributed within known camps and throughout the city.
 - Dispatch rides available. Call 615-844-3399 to schedule pick up.
 - Bug spray
 - Sunscreen
 - Cool towels
 - Service coordination & Coordinated Entry

NASHVILLE PUBLIC LIBRARY

- **Hours:** Visit <https://library.nashville.gov/locations>
- **Bus Route Locations:** Bellevue, Bordeaux, Donelson, Madison, and Southeast.
- **Services:** Locations have air conditioning, restrooms, and drinking fountains, as well as computers and power outlets for charging phones and other devices.
- **The Main Library is temporarily closed.**

OPEN TABLE NASHVILLE

- **Hours:** Green Street: Wednesdays from 3:00–5:00 PM
- Trinity Community Commons: Tuesdays from 4:30–6:30 PM
- First Evangelical Lutheran Church: Mondays from 10:00 AM–12:00 PM
- **Services:** Fridays (Downtown & Surrounding Areas): Outreach teams distribute meals and supplies, focusing on specific encampments and individuals they are actively supporting.
- **Outreach Supplies:** Seasonal items are available at all locations listed above. Supplies include bottled water, cooling towels, sunscreen, bug spray, and bus passes.
