If you are not satisfied with a decision of the Metropolitan Beer Permit Board regarding your application or your hearing, you may appeal the decision to the Davidson County Chancery or Circuit Court pursuant to the requirements set forth in T.C.A. 57-5-108. The decisions of the Metropolitan Beer Permit Board take effect on a date to be determined by the board. However, you may file an appeal within 60 days of the date of entry of the board's decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met.

Mr. Darby informed the Board that staff are in the early stages of developing new beer permit categories, with potential options including BYOB establishments, food trucks, and delivery services. He also reported that a training program for new applicants is currently in development.

Mr. Brown informed the Board that the first case involving the sale of beer to a minor was recently adjudicated in Environmental Court. He noted that this new process is preferable, as it holds the individual who committed the violation accountable without creating a criminal record. Instead of issuing a criminal citation, the individual is required to pay court costs and complete the Beer Board's training program.
