Collier Engineering Co Inc

Strengths – Proposal demonstrated a detailed and concise narrative about firm and firm's capacity to perform the scope of services. Proposal demonstrated staff that have relevant experience with TDOT Local Programs. Proposal demonstrated only individuals with TDOT Local Programs CEI Level 2 certifications. Proposal demonstrated that leadership and staff had TDOT experience and certification. Overall proposal was structured in an easily readable format. Proposal included a clear and understandable organizational chart. Proposal included an extensive list of inspected contractors.

Weaknesses – Proposed subconsultant list lacked details (who they were and what is being performed). Resumes included in proposal lacked detail. Proposal demonstrated a description of the team but lacked detail regarding individual experience with local programs. Business plan proposal lacked details regarding community outreach. Business plan and approach lacked detail and was generic compared to other offerors. Proposal demonstrated a generic response for why the team is best suited for this project. Proposal listed cities and work throughout the state but lacked project details regarding the type of project as well as other project details compared to other offerors.

Gresham Smith

Strengths – Proposal demonstrated strong leadership experience with sidewalk projects on state routes and certifications. Proposal demonstrated depth of sidewalk inspection experience. Proposal demonstrated a detailed business plan and approach. Proposal demonstrated a detailed list of contractors whose work has been inspected. Proposal included a clear and understandable organizational chart. Proposal included an extensive list of inspected contractors.

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Weaknesses – Subconsultant form was provided but proposal PDF failed to provide list of firms proposed sub-consultants. Proposal lacked information regarding roles and responsibilities for subconsultants. Proposal failed to demonstrate specific information about TDOT Local Programs CEI Level 2 certifications. Proposal provided a combined response for detailed plan of approach and inspection process. Inspection process included in proposal was vague and lacked details. Proposal provided list of issues but failed to provide any details or specifics regarding the issues. Proposal included a list of issues and limited risks but failed to demonstrate countermeasures you would employ to minimize and overcome those issues. Business plan Proposal lacked details regarding community outreach. Proposal demonstrated a generic response for why the team is best suited for this project. Relevant project experience was provided in a table which resulted in detail being limited compared to other offerors. Relevant project experience failed to include project length information. Some relevant project experiences are not specific projects but rather programs or indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity contracts. Relevant project experience failed to demonstrate any subconsultant experience. Some resumes provided do not include specific project experience related to TDOT Local Project and associated certifications. Proposal included irrelevant information that doesn't align with scope.

Lamar Dunn & Associates, Inc dba LDA Engineering

Strengths – Proposal demonstrated a detailed and concise narrative about firm and firm's capacity to perform the scope of services. Proposal demonstrated TDOT Level 2 Certifications as well as other certifications. Proposal demonstrated that the risk and risk mitigation table was clear and concise. *Proposal included a clear and understandable organizational chart*.

Weaknesses – Proposal resumes lack relevant details and included information that were not of similar scope. Other than within resume, proposal didn't focus or mention anything regarding TDOT Level 2 certifications. Capacity to Perform proposal was generic and lacked detailed regarding local programs projects. Business plan proposal lacked details regarding community outreach. Approach proposal was vague and failed to address NDOT specific issues. Inspection process within proposal lacked detail compared to other offerors. Relevant project experience lacked local programs details. Relevant project experiences are not specific projects but rather programs or indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity contracts. Relevant project experience included design projects which are not of similar scope for this project. Relevant project experience failed to demonstrate if work was performed by the prime or subconsultant.

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Proposal response as to why team is best suited was genetic and lacked depth compared to other offerors. Proposal listed cities and work throughout the state but lacked project details regarding the type of project as well as other project details compared to other offerors.

Smith Seckman Reid Inc

Strengths – Proposal demonstrated strong leadership experience with some certifications and state route experience.

Weaknesses - Proposal failed to demonstrate specific information about TDOT Local Programs CEI Level 2 certifications. Capacity to perform lacked detail compared to other offerors. Proposal lacked detail regarding roles and responsibilities of team members. Proposal lacked individual information to demonstrate appropriate experience. Detailed plan of approach was not well presented and didn't give any details to complete the work. Proposal lacked detail regarding key issues and inspection process compared to other offerors. Proposal failed to demonstrate any risks and associated mitigations. List of inspected contractors provided in proposal was smaller number compared to other offerors. Proposal demonstrated a generic response for why the team is best suited for this project. Relevant project experience involving local programs projects is limited compared to other offerors. Proposal included table rather than organizational chart.

Volkert Inc

Strengths - Proposed business plan was detailed and good compared to others.

Weaknesses - Proposal failed to demonstrate specific information about TDOT Local Programs CEI Level 2 certifications. Proposal lacked detail regarding roles and responsibilities of team members. Proposal demonstrated some experienced staff, but some resumes didn't demonstrate experience for others. Projects on some resumes are not of similar scope. Inspection process included in proposal was vague and lacked details. Approach proposal lacked detail compared to other offerors. Understanding key issues lacked detail compared to other offerors. Proposal failed to mention risks and associated mitigations. Proposal demonstrated a generic response for why the team is best suited for this project compared to other offerors. Some relevant project experiences are not specific projects but rather programs or indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity contracts. Proposal demonstrated TDOT Projects but lacked information or details regarding local programs projects. Organizational chart lacked detail compared to other offerors.
