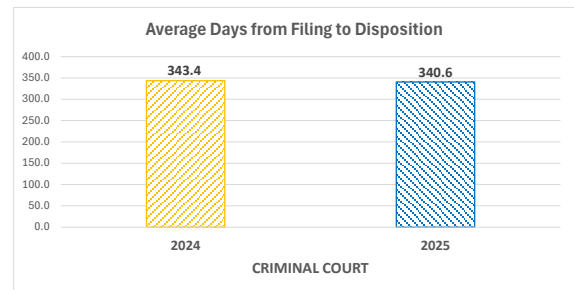

**CASE MANAGEMENT ANALYSIS
2025 THROUGH 3rd QUARTER**

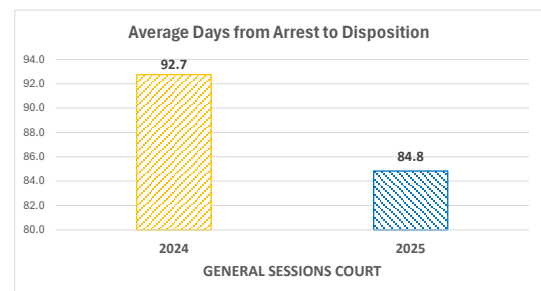
Criminal Court Summary:

1. The time from filing in Criminal Court to disposition was 340.6 days, a decline of 2.8 days below the same period in 2024.
2. The average time from filing to disposition for indicted defendants was 423.1 days, a decline of 0.3 day.
3. The average case age for defendants disposed by Information Agreements declined 13.9 days to a total of 43.8 days.
4. Direct Presentments averaged 445.5 days from filing to disposition, an increase of 20.4 days.
5. Defendants disposed in Criminal Court without a trial took 324.3 days to dispose, a decline of 8.5 days. The case age for trial defendants was 988.4 days, an increase of 14.6 days above 2024.
6. Jailed defendants in Criminal Court took 268.9 days to process from filing to disposition, 5.1 days shorter than 2024. The average time from filing to disposition for bond defendants was 407.7 days, which was 12.7 days longer than in 2024.
7. The number of defendants who were served a capias in Criminal Court declined 3.9%. The impact of these capias on the average case processing time was 24.0 days, which was 1.3 days shorter than the same period in 2024.
8. Defendants with a probation violation in Criminal Court averaged 62.4 days from PV arrest to PV disposition. This was a longer time (+6.8 days) compared to the previous year.



General Sessions Court Summary:

1. The average time from arrest to disposition in General Sessions Court was 84.8 days, a decline of 7.9 days.
2. The average time for defendants who were to bound over to Criminal Court was 57.7 days, a decline of 10.0 days.
3. For defendants whose warrants were concluded without a trial (pled or dismissed), the average time from arrest to disposition was 94.6 days, a decline of 6.9 days.
4. The average time to dispose jailed defendants was 14.4 days, a decline of 1.6 days. Defendants on bond averaged 134.1 days. That represented a decrease of 6.0 days below 2024 levels.
5. The number of General Sessions defendants served a capias increased 2.0% in 2024 through Q3. The impact the capias had on the average case age was 13.5 days, which was 1.8 days longer than the same period in 2024.

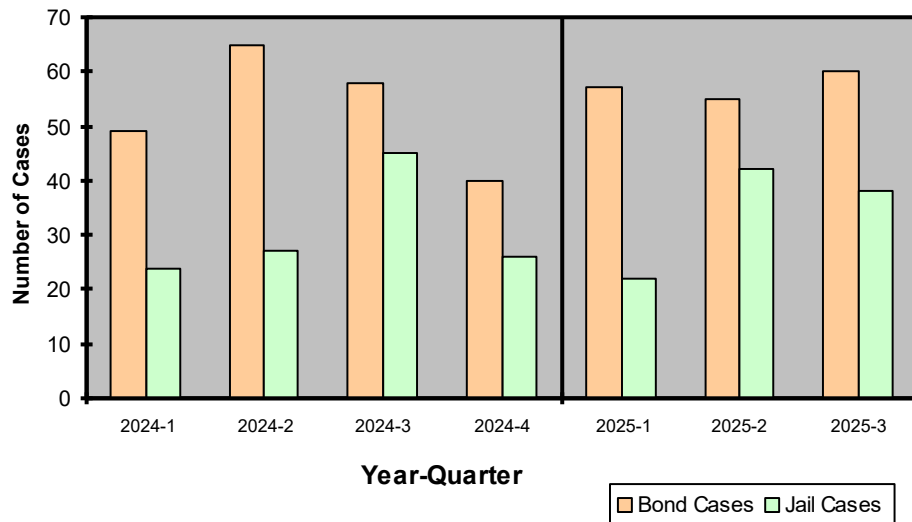

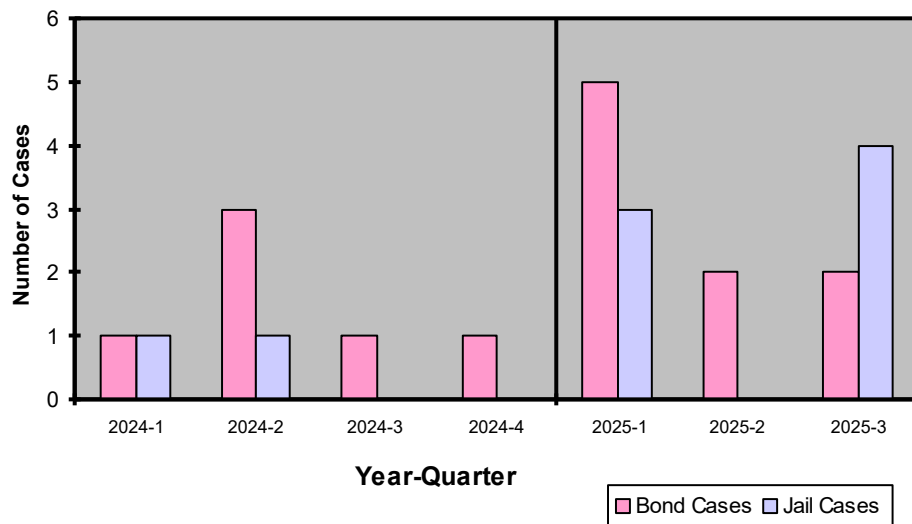
Disposed Without a Trial Number of Cases



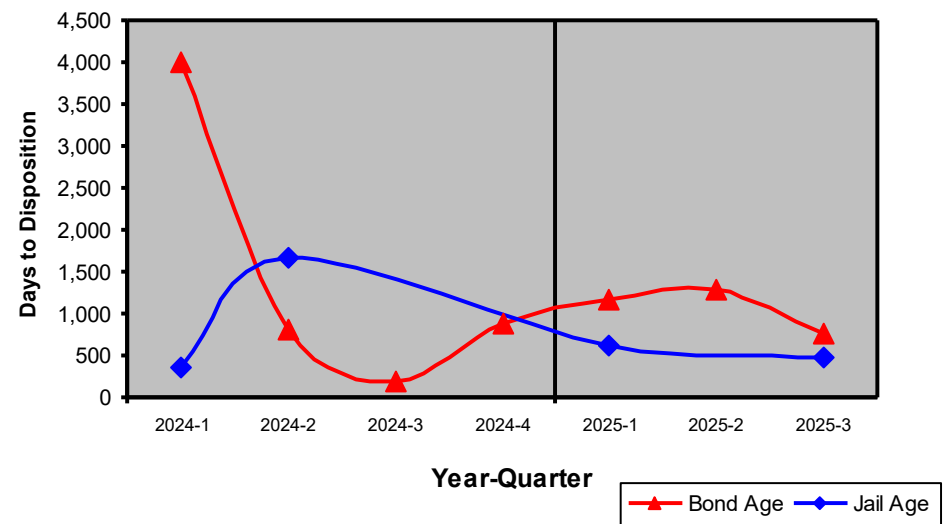
Disposed Without a Trial Average Days to Disposition



Disposed by Trial Number of Cases

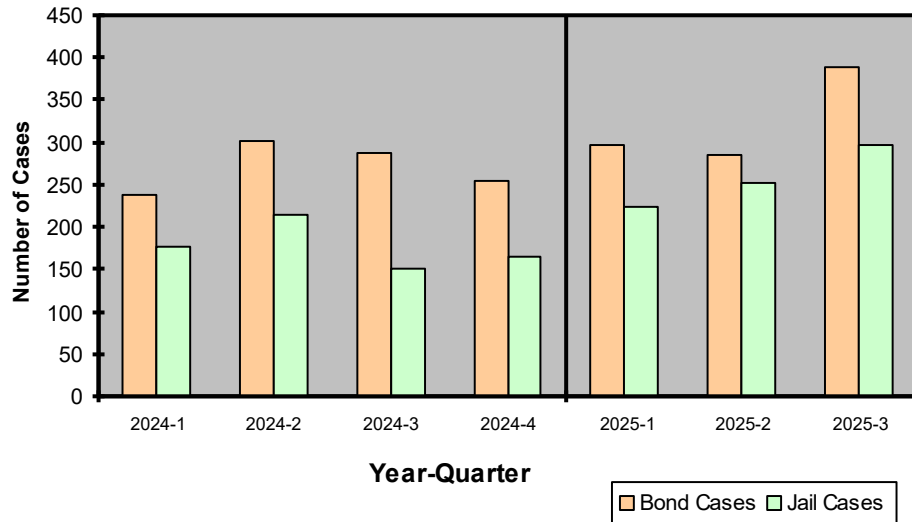

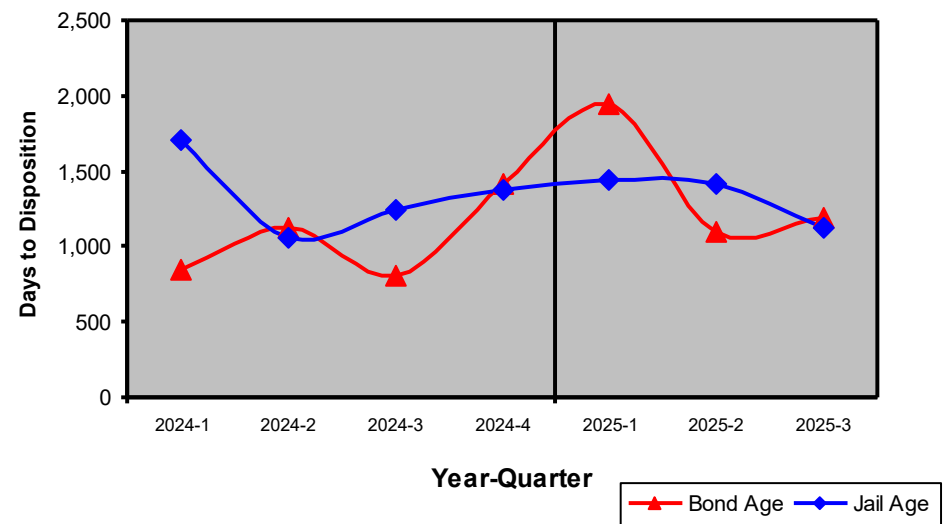
**Disposed Without a Trial
Average Days to Disposition**



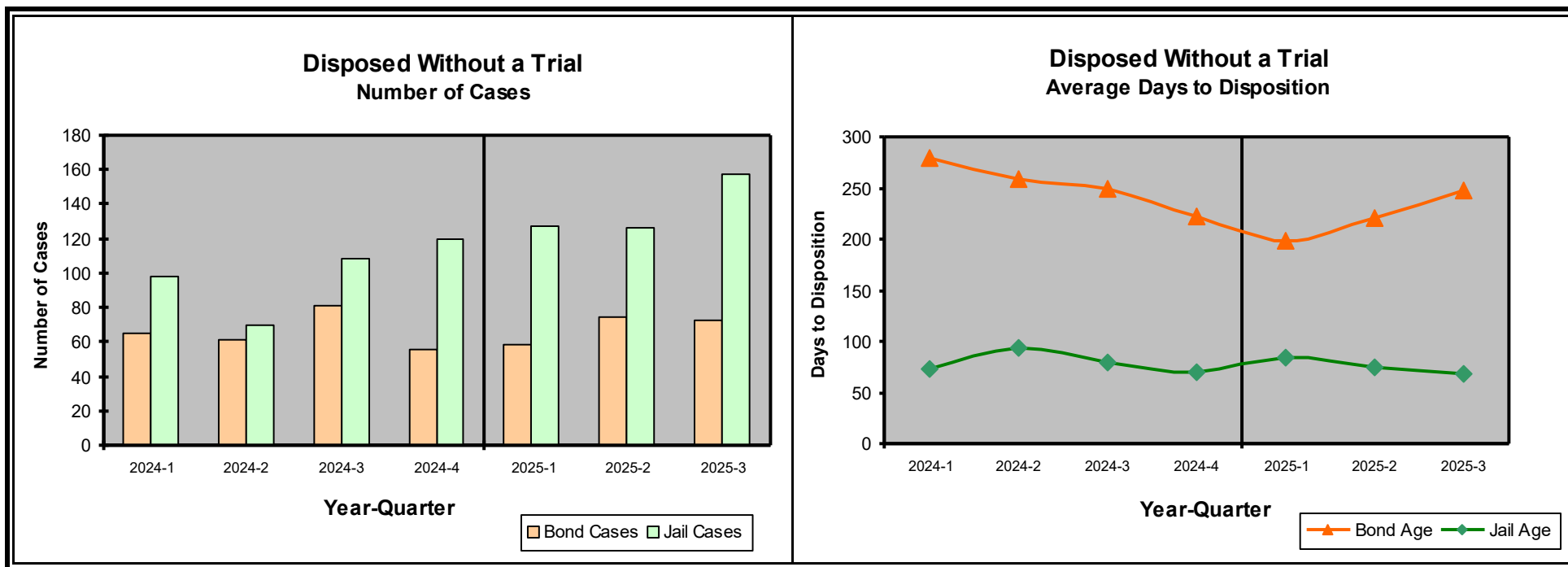

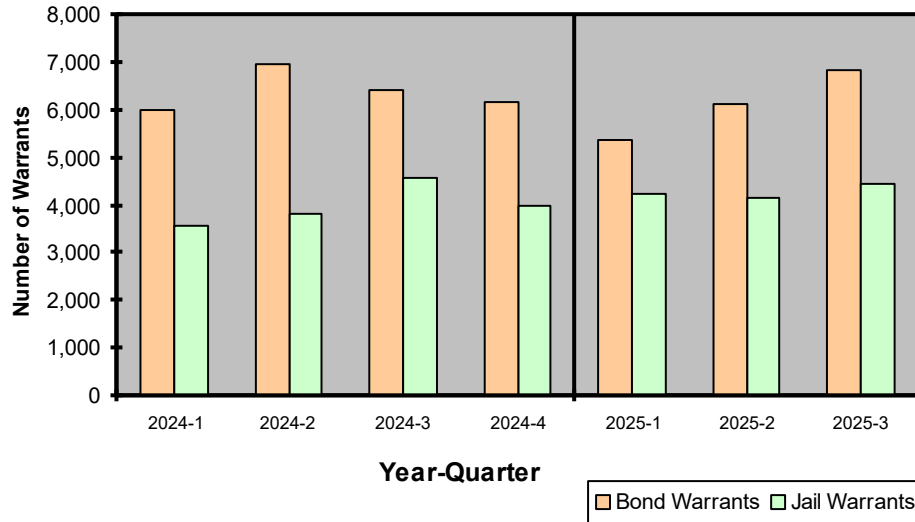

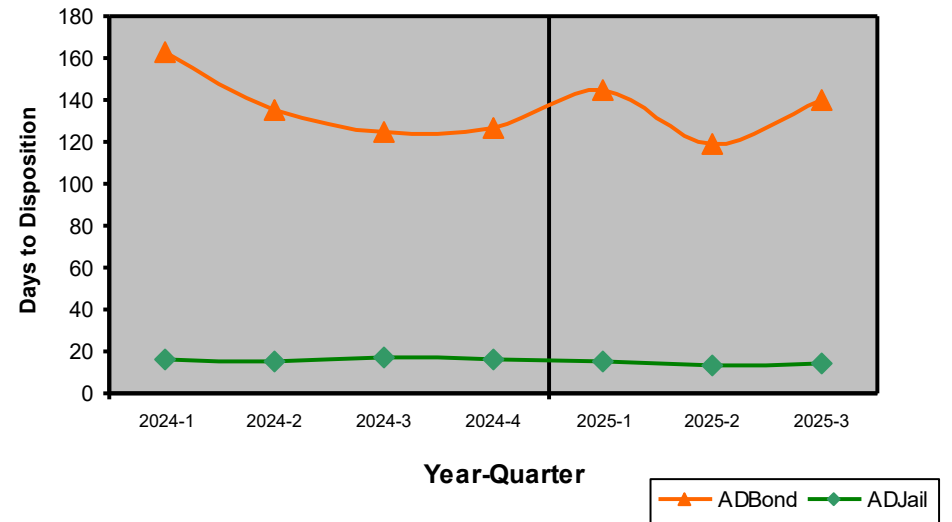

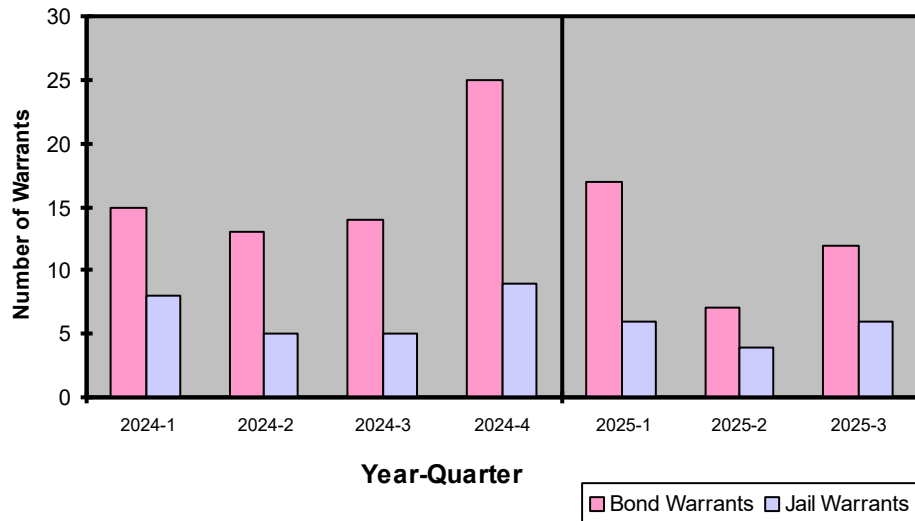
**Bindover/Concluded Without a Trial
Number of Warrants**



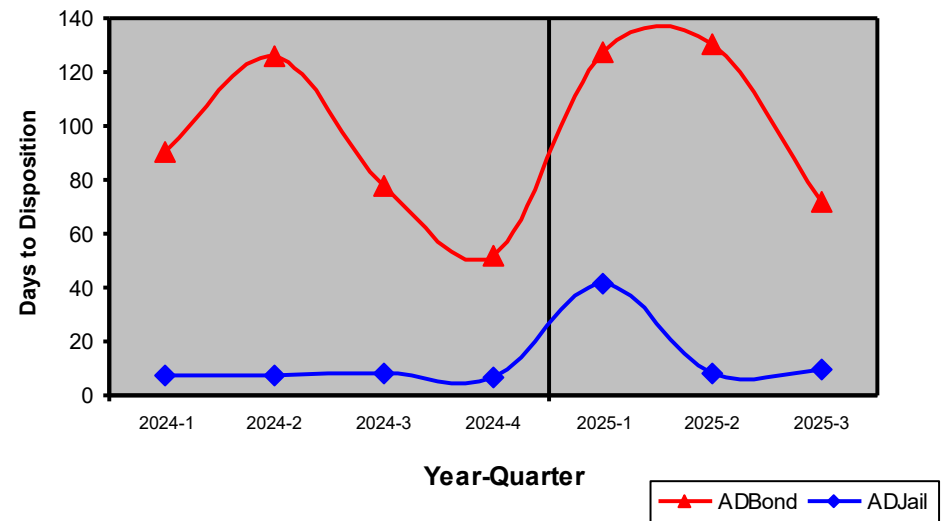
**Bindover/Concluded Without a Trial

Notes:

1. This report is provided on a quarterly basis as a management tool to criminal justice leaders. The purpose of this report is to assist court managers and judges in monitoring the flow of cases through the court system. Successful case flow management can help avoid and reduce unnecessary delay as well as allow more efficient use of time and other resources. This report was developed using guidelines established by the National Center for State Courts. It provides statistics on the average time it takes cases to move from arrest to disposition of the case, for the current year compared to the same time period in the previous year. This analysis is also available by Criminal Court Division.
2. For this report, an outlier test procedure of two standard deviations from the mean is used to determine extreme values which could skew the statistics. Two standard deviations around the mean account for roughly 95 percent of the data population. Values that are determined to be outside two standard deviations are excluded from the statistical calculations. Therefore, the number of cases and defendants reported here is not intended to represent the total number of cases and defendants disposed during the time period.
3. Criminal Court cases are included in this report when all counts for a defendant are disposed. Each defendant is analyzed separately. Therefore, a Criminal Court case can be included in more than one time period if there are multiple defendants with their final count disposed in different quarters.
4. Concerning data on jury trials: This report provides data on the average length of time to dispose a case/defendant therefore it does not include when a jury mistrials and the case remains open. It is also unable to distinguish when a defendant enters a guilty plea after a jury has been impaneled for a trial. At this time the data in CJIS provides no way to accurately identify those cases that started, but did not end, as a jury trial, nor measure the time spent in a trial prior to the guilty plea. Therefore in this report trial cases are defined as cases disposed and recorded in CJIS with disposition by either jury trial or bench trial.

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
