- III. 10-25-02** The Nashville Predators request approval of a lease agreement for the portion of the Centennial Sportsplex that includes both ice rinks and the concession area. Under the proposed lease, the team would assume operational control of this area in a manner consistent with its management of the two Ford Ice Centers. In consideration, the Predators would be responsible for major capital improvements at the beginning and throughout the lease term, as well as all insurance costs for the leased premises. Metro would also receive a share of the net revenue generated from ice rink operations. Council District 21.

- 10-25-10** Staff requests approval of a dedicated Conservation Greenway Easement property at NO ADDRESS, NASHVILLE, TN 00000, Map and Parcel #032160B90500CO, NO ADDRESS, NASHVILLE, TN 00000, Map and Parcel # 032160B90600CO, and NO ADDRESS, NASHVILLE, TN 00000, Map and Parcel 032160B90700CO, along Little Creek. These greenway easements will conserve 1.64 acres of open space and provide for future expansion of the Whites Creek Greenway network. The easements dedication was a condition of the Planning Commission's approval of the final plat for Heritage Creek Phase 5, 2019S-068-005. Council District 3.
