**04-26-03** McCabe Park Little League requests acceptance of an in-kind grant valued at approximately \$78,500 to add lighting to the small baseball field at McCabe Ball Park. No matching funds are required from Metro Parks, as McCabe Park Little League will cover all expenses associated with the improvement project and will also cover the additional electrical costs for the new lighting. - 04-26-04** Staff requests approval of a dedicated Conservation Greenway Easement on property at 92 WHITE BRIDGE PIKE, NASHVILLE, TN 37205, Map and Parcel 10311000100, to serve as a connector to the Richland Creek Greenway. This greenway easement will conserve 0.438 acres of open space and provide expansion of the Richland Creek Greenway network. The easement dedication was a condition of the Planning Commission's approval of the final site plan for Novel Richland Creek, 2021-009-002. Council District 24.
- 04-26-05** The Centennial Park Conservancy requests approval to install an engraved Crabtree stone section at the entrance of the new Event Pavilion located in Centennial Park to recognize Phase III donors, organized by levels of contribution. Additionally, the Conservancy requests approval to install a donor recognition plaque at the renovated Croquet Cafe' to honor contributors to the Phase III revitalization project. Two design options are submitted: one utilizing the Parks standard plaque layout and font, the other incorporating the Parks approved Croquet Cafe' branding logo. Council District 21.
- 04-26-06** The Friends of Warner Parks requests acceptance of an in-kind grant not to exceed \$1,200,000 to fund the renovation of the Warner Park Nature Center barn and shed. This renovation will support the Nature Discovery Program providing flexible, year-round educational space, allowing WPNC to sustain and expand programming while creating new opportunities for environmental learning and outdoor exploration. The renovation will also include site and visitor improvements and a workshop space to relocate maintenance and storage functions. Council District 34.
- 04-26-07** The Metro Historical Commission requests approval to install a new historical marker commemorating Joseph B. Mullins, and John Michael Mallette within the boundary of Joseph Mullins Park. This historical marker is being funded by private donations to the Metro Historical Commission. No donation is being made to Metro Parks. There will be no cost for Metro Parks, and no ongoing maintenance requirement. - 04-26-08** Friends of Sevier Park requests acceptance of a cash grant in the amount of \$20,909 to fund repairs to the flooring at Stone House located in front of Sunnyside Mansion and for replacement of the backstop at the park's multi-use field. Metro Parks will handle all purchasing and improvements. No match is required from Metro Parks. Council District 18.
- 04-26-09** Friends of Sevier Park requests acceptance of an in-kind grant of \$5,600 for improvements at Sevier Park. This includes \$5,000 for the purchase of supplies and equipment for the community center and \$600 for the purchase of a wheel kit for newly installed soccer goals. No funds will be transferred to Metro Parks; all items will be purchased directly by Friends of Sevier Park. No financial match is required from Metro Parks. Council District 18.
- 04-26-10** Greenways for Nashville (GFN) requests approval to amend a previously accepted \$270,000 in-kind grant to revise project locations, expand improvements to additional greenways, and extend the project term by two years. All work will be completed by GFN vendors, with an estimated value not to exceed \$310,000. No matching funds or additional obligations are required from Metro Parks. Council District Citywide.
- 04-26-11** Friends of Shelby Park and Bottoms requests acceptance of an in-kind grant valued at approximately \$3,600 to fund bus rentals for the Summer Enrichment Programs at the Kirkpatrick, McFerrin, Cleveland, East, and South Inglewood Community Centers to visit Shelby Park and Bottoms.
