Students will spend time discovering and developing their theater talents and will have a chance to showcase what they learn in a low stakes performance setting.

Classes offered in: Musical Theater, Improvisation, Theater Dance, Acting, Acting for Film, & Shakespeare

Musical Theater

Learn acting, singing and dancing skills.

Primary Musical Theater | 5-9 years

A playful introduction to singing, dancing, and acting! Kids explore storytelling through song, learn basic stage movement, and build confidence while working together. Games encourage listening, expression, and imagination.
