- III. 07-26-10** Staff requests approval of a TDOT land dedication of approximately 49.94 acres at 7820 COLEY DAVIS RD for continued park use. The property has long been leased by Metro and serves as part of Harpeth River Park, including a soccer facility and greenway segment. Acquiring the property will place it under Metro ownership, ensuring its long-term preservation for park purposes, expanding Metro's park inventory and providing greater control over future improvements. The acquisition will also support expansion of the Harpeth River Greenway network, improve connectivity to a planned greenway on an adjacent 51-acre underdeveloped park property, allow for construction of a vehicular access bridge, and facilitate the addition of 25 acres of new parkland.
