Code Provision: Plumbing and Mechanical Appeal for proposed use as a cigar lounge (with non permitted existing kitchen). Per Table 2902.1 a 2nd restroom is required for the proposed cigar lounge, assembly occupancy. (At least 1 of 2 restrooms must be accessible). Proposed use as a cigar lounge to comply with ventilation requirements per Table 403.3.1.1 of the 2024 IMC.

Variance Requested: Appealing two items:

1. Plumbing per table 2902.1 (2nd restroom) not needed due to lack of physical space and occupant load. The one restroom I have is accessible (to accommodate up to 50 people occupant load).
2. Mechanical per table 403.3.1.1 (ventilation) for the utilized SQ FT space, I have two air purifiers to control air ventilation for up to 3,000 SF per unit (6,000 SF total) and the building is 954 SF total.

Code Provision: Per 2024 IMC - Section 504.6 states domestic booster fans shall not be installed in dryer exhaust systems.

Variance Requested: Appellant is requesting the use of dryer booster fans to extend existing dryer ducts in the crawlspaces of the garden-style apartment Buildings D, E, F, J, K, R, S, X & Y to the exterior for specific vents that can not do so within 35 effective feet. Engineer specified fans shall be DEDPV-705. The noted buildings of the apartment community are located across 3 of the 4 phases/parcels that make up the apartment community as a whole. Engineering plans and letter are included and the building types in question can be found on pages M104 and M105.

Per 2018 IMC - Section 504.5 and 504.6, the dryer duct booster fans were allowed. Per 2024 IMC which was adopted by Metro Nashville on July 15, 2025, Section 504.6 'Booster Fans Prohibited' is a new section that was added. The variance request is to confirm if allowed to be grandfathered in under 2018 IMC and allow the booster fans to be installed. Rather than keep existing grandfathered venting as is, owner wishes to take ducts to exterior for health and safety purposes.
