

MNAA RESOLUTION NO. 2026-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE METROPOLITAN NASHVILLE AIRPORT AUTHORITY SUPPORTS CHANGING THE NAME OF THE NASHVILLE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TO HONOR THE LATE DOLLY PARTON.

WHEREAS, the current MNAA Policy 33-006 was updated November 27, 2024.

WHEREAS, MNAA Policy 33-006, Section IV, Process, paragraph E. The Board has sole authority regarding any change in name to a named building, space, facility or street or any changes in a Naming Rights Agreement, if applicable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE METROPOLITAN NASHVILLE AIRPORT AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority Board of Commissioners supports changing the name of the Nashville International Airport to honor the late Dolly Parton and directs the President and CEO to immediately begin the process to effectuate the change in consultation with and subject to approval of Dolly Parton's estate and other appropriate entities, create a timeline and implementation plan for all necessary approvals and determine the estimated costs associated with the renaming of the airport in honor of Dolly Parton.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption and be made a part of the Board of Commissioners official Minutes of Record.

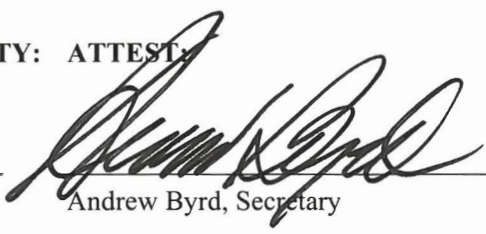
