SIGNAGE COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS APPROVAL TO INSTALL A DOUBLE-SIDED LIGHTED SIGN, IN THE WALK OF FAME PARK VALUED AT APPROXIMATELY \$12,500

Upon a motion by Mr. DeLay, seconded by Mr. Henley, and following discussion, the Signage Committee recommended approval of the Nashville Convention & Visitors Corporation's (NCVC) request to install a double-sided lighted sign, valued at \$12,500 in the Walk of Fame Park. The sign, intended to enhance the visitor experience, will include a QR code linking visitors to digital content highlighting inductees' connections to Nashville. The NCVC will provide the sign, coordinate installation with Metro Parks, and cover all future maintenance of the sign through Nashville Downtown Partnership. Council District 21.
