



## **SPIKE Automatic Text Program**

Since June 2021, the Metro Public Health Department of Nashville/Davidson County is partnering with [Partnership to End Addiction](#) to implement an auto text program that alerts those who opt-in about spikes in overdose activity occurring in the county.

Parents, caregivers, medical professionals, first responders, community groups and those struggling with substance use in Davidson County can **sign up** for the Partnership's SPIKE Auto Text Program.

Davidson County residents can receive free, direct notifications of overdose spike activity on their mobile device, which can help prevent local overdose deaths.

**Individuals can sign up by texting EndOD to 55753 and following the prompts.** They will receive overdose prevention messages. Sign up can also be done by **texting SPIKE to 1 (855) 963-5669 (855-9-OD-KNOW)**
